Class Projects for MOA 110 class

OBJECTIVE:

The purpose of the project is to help students develop the necessary skills used in a medical office or clinic to teach and educate patients about their medical conditions. The students will research a common disease or medical condition that brings a patient to the doctor to manage. One of the functions of medical office personnel is patient teaching and the project will help student develop the skills to be patient educators.

PROJECT OUTLINE:

- A) Students will research disease conditions that are commonly seen in medical offices that need long-term management. For example: diabetes, smoking cessation, hypertension, gout, migraines, high cholesterol, obesity, kidney stones, healthy pregnancies, childbirth, dental hygiene, GERD, irritable bowel syndrome, medication management, COPD, Parkinson's disease, back pain, heart disease, breast cancer, etc.
- B) With their research, students will develop a power point presentation about the condition and present it to the class who will act as "clinic patients" for the talk.
- C) They will prepare a brochure using their research to give to the "patients" and indicate that the classes are open to patients and their families.
- D) The classes will be taught at a larger conference center so the students will need to make a map, directions, and available parking handout for the people attending the class. This skill to be introduced to MOA students is called way finding.
- E) Students need to be creative and use plenty of graphics for their power point presentations and make the slides fairly simple without a lot of verbiage to help patients grasp essential concepts.
