3. Literature review – summarizes the key research items.
4. Findings – critical analysis of the issues and root causes associated with the problem being investigated
5. Recommendations

Written Assignment Expectations

Length: 2500 words

Structure: Include a title page and reference page in APA style. These do not count towards the minimal word amount for this assignment.

References: Use the appropriate APA style in-text citations and references for all resources utilized to answer the questions. Include at least five (5) scholarly sources to support your claims.

Format: Save your assignment as a Microsoft Word document (.doc or .docx).

File name: Name your saved file according to your first initial, last name, and the module number (for example, "RHall BUS 499 Module 8.docx")

Presentation Assignment Expectations

The presentation portion of the Capstone Project Report must address the following points with regards to your development through the different stages of the capstone course:

- Title Slide (1 slide) – Project title, student name, Course #
- Overview of Project Topic/Problem (1-2 slides)
- Key Findings from the Literature Review (2-3 slides)
- Overview of the Findings (1-2 slides)
- What You Discovered during the Project Investigation (3-4 slides)
- Recommendations for Solving the problem you chose (1-2 slides)

- Reference Slide (1-2 slides)

Use clear headings that allow your professor to know which bullet you are addressing on the slides in your presentation. Support the content with at least five (5) citations throughout the presentation. Make sure to reference the citations using the APA writing style for the presentation. Include a reference slide at the end. Follow best practices for PowerPoint and Prezi presentations related to text size, color, images, effects, wordiness, and multimedia enhancements.
