<b>Introduction</b> The paper contains an introduction, which introduces the issue being critiqued (from Daniel) and includes a clear position on the topic of choice (via a thesis statement). <b>20 Points</b>			
<b>Issue Major Findings</b> The paper presents a clear and logical argument to help support the position on the issue. The paper contains at least 6 appropriate sources of scholarly support (majoring findings in the literature found in journals or other peer-reviewed periodicals) that help reinforce the position of the paper. This support is successfully and smoothly woven into the paper's argument/thesis. <b>70 Points</b>	<b>18 – 20 Points</b>	<b>14 – 17 Points</b>	<b>0 – 13 Points</b>
<b>Conclusion</b> The paper includes a conclusion that re-introduces the position. The conclusion offers up ideas for future directions and ends with universal statements regarding the issue of choice. <b>30 Points</b>	<b>63 – 70 Points</b>	<b>49 – 62 Points</b>	<b>0 – 48 Points</b>

<b>Adherence to APA Style</b> The paper is between 5-6 pages in length.
