# Term paper guidelines

### **Task**

To comply with the university policy regarding courses, a student taking this course for graduate credit will be required to write a graduate term paper on a topic assigned by the instructor.

A term paper is a research-based writing assignment that contains arguments or persuasions supported with facts taken from a many reliable sources, such as academic papers, scholarly magazines or textbooks. The paper requires a lot of researches and technical writing skills on the assigned topic.

## 1. Proposal

The first step is choosing your topic. You can suggest a creative topic or choose one from the list that you are particularly interested in. Understand the background of the topic and organize all of the points that you wish to bring up in your paper. The length of the document can be  $1 \sim 2$  pages.

#### 2. Final submission

You are submitting a completed term paper. The length of the term paper must be  $5 \sim 6$  pages.

- 2. Introduction

- 4. Methodology
  - 4.1. Method (A detail description of your research method)
  - 4.2. Method2 (Algorithm)
  - 4.3. Method3 (Implementation/Experimental approaches)
- 5. Results (Your findings from your research with figures and graphs)
- Conclusion
