1. (U) Situation:

- a. Elements of 1st Company, Ariana 3251st Special Purpose Force (SPF) Brigade Airborne are conducting operations in AO Wolverine (Ann Arbor). They have the task to defend key terrain, mission command nodes, mortar firing positions, and cache sites throughout the AO. Their purpose is to set the conditions for a 1st Mechanized (Ariana) attack south into AO Wolverine.
 - i. Area of Interest: South boundary Geddes Rd east to west from Washtenaw Ave to Huron Pkwy. North boundary Fuller Rd east to west from Glen Ave to Huron Pkwy. West boundary is Washtenaw Ave, East boundary Huron Pkwy.
 - ii. Area of Operation: Nicholas Arboretum.
 - iii. Key Terrain: OCOKA
- b. Enemy Forces: Special Purpose Force (SPF)
 - i. Typically composed of 2-3 man teams, lightly armed with AK-47 rifles. Also occasionally have use of vehicles, and may have bunkers with crew- served weapons.
 - ii. Enemy Forces have a forward line of troops just north of Ann Arbor with its boundaries consisting of M13 and M23 with strong defensive positions established at 17T KG 7428 8897 at their lower left quadrant of operating area. SPF have pushed south into the Nicholas Arboretum and have constructed hasty fighting positions and sporadic attacks.
 - iii. MLCOA: SPF forces will conduct sporadic attacks to assess the capabilities of US forces but will not remain engaged. Sabotage and ambushes will be the key offensive actions.
 - iv. MDCOA: If SPF is placed in a situation they cannot retrograde from they will make last stand with motars called in to their position.
- c. Friendly Forces: A Co, Wolverine BN
 - i. (HQ) Wolverine BN
 - a. Mission: Conduct offensive and defensive operations within AO Wolverine for the next 90 days to deny enemy forces freedom of maneuver, destroy enemy forces and equipment, and detect enemy main forces pushing south into AO Wolverine.
 - ii. A Co will establish Tactical Base Arb on the West entrance of the Arb vicinity 17T KG 752 845.
 - iii. B Co will be conducting clearing operations west of Washtenaw Ave.
 - iv. C Co will establish QRF
- d. Attachments/Detachments: Combat Engineer PLT; Fire Support Team; 81mm Mortar PLT; Medics,

2. (U) Mission:

A Co will establish Tactical Base Arb in order to conduct offensive and defensive

operations to destroy enemy fighting positions, and deny SPF freedom of maneuver within the Nicholas Arboretum. On order establish a screen on the south side of Huron River to delay the advance of 1st Mechanized BN (Ariana)

3. (U) Execution

Intent: NLT 120800DEC21 Conduct offensive and defensive operations to deny enemy freedom of maneuver and its ability to penetrate into the Nicholas Arboretum, and destroy enemy fighting positions.

a. Commander's Intent

- i. Purpose: The purpose of our initial operation is to reduce the enemy capabilities and freedom of movement within the AO
- ii. Key Tasks:
 1. Conduct detailed planning and rehearsals to ensure our forces are prepared for various contingencies and unforeseen challenges during the conduct of missions.
 2. Conduct aggressive offensive and defensive operations to kill/capture SPF and their support material.
- iii. Endstate: SPF is degraded to combat ineffective numbers or repelled from the company AO. BPT to conduct follow on missions with new intelligence gathered. Civilian population will have minimal impact.

b. Concept of Operation

- i. Phase I: The Advance party will deploy to western entrance of Nicholas Arboretum from BN AA NLT 120500DEC21. ADVON will establish recon site covering TB Arb area unit NLT 120600DEC21, to prepare for arrival of 1st PLT. The main body deployment will occur with order of march 1, HQ, 2, and 3.
- ii. Phase II: 1st PLT will take lead ensuring communications with advance party of any intelligence gathered from the site recon. Conduct clearing operations up to a 200 meter radius beyond the identified TB boundaries. With The remainder of the Company following and establishing Patrol Base Operations.
- iii. Phase III: 2nd PLT will establish work/rest cycle and establish QRF planning to be linked in with 1st PLTs defensive operation of TB Arb. 3rd PLT will begin to plan and rehearse offensive operations to clear the Nicholas Arboretum.
- iv. Phase IV: NLT 120800DEC21 1st PLT will conduct offensive operations within the Company AO.
- v. Phase V: Begin when SPF has been degraded to combat ineffective numbers or repelled from the company AO.

c. Scheme of Manuever:

- i. 1st PLT: Advance party established NLT 120600DEC21, Secure TB Arb NLT 120700DEC21.
- ii. 2nd PLT: Establish QRF for the duration of the operations based out of TB Arb.
- iii. 3rd PLT: Plan, rehearse, and execute offensive operations within the Company AO.
- iv. HQ: Establish Company TOC and communication with higher HQ.

d. Tasks to Maneuver Units:

- i. 1st PLT: Establish reconnaissance site with PLT FO
- ii. 2nd PLT: Rehearse QRF and identify all routes and obstacles within the Co AO.
- iii. 3rd PLT: Rehearse Battle Drills; 2 x AT4 per squad, and establish FSEM, and Target List worksheet.

1. What locations are SPF cache sites found
2. What location are SPF fighting positions found
3. Where are SPF HQ/C2 nodes located
4. Locations of SPF/Arianan IDF positions

ii. FFIR

1. Loss of Soldier, weapon, or sensitive item
2. Injury to civilian personnel or property
3. Death or injury to Soldier
4. Troops in contact with enemy forces

g. Graphic Control Measures

- i. Crossing platoon boundaries not permitted without approval from A Co TOC.

1. Minimum resupply capabilities during operations, all soldier deploy with full combat load
2. Daily resupply will be available from BN as needed

v. Class VIII (Medical)

1. Each platoon will deploy with a CLS bag, VS-17 panel, two pole-less liters, red, blue, yellow chemlights, and purple smoke for marking.
