

ACC 693 Module One Journal Guidelines and Rubric

Overview: Journal assignments in this course are private between you and the instructor. A course Journal is generally made up of multiple individual assignments.

In this journal assignment, you will choose the case study for your final project. There are four types of <u>fraud schemes</u> to choose from. This project will expose you to the steps included in an actual computerized investigation.

Prompt: Review the case studies in Chapter 11 of *Data Analytics for Auditing Using ACL*. There are four case studies you may choose from for your final project. Post your selection with a brief explanation of your choice. Why did you decide to work with this fraud scheme?

Specifically, the following critical elements must be addressed:

- Submit your choice of a case study.
- Explain your **selection** by providing a detailed paragraph about your choice of a fraud scheme.
