QUESTIONS TO ANSWER IN YOUR SCHIZOPHRENIA CASE STUDY PAPER

Questions about Dr. Saks' TED talk

- 1. Which symptoms of schizophrenia does Dr. Saks describe in her TED talk?
- 2. Schizphrenia is often a debilitating illness that makes it difficult to function in everyday life. How was Dr. Saks able to pursue such a successful career despite having schizophrenia?

Questions about Janet (case vignette)

- 3. What is the precipitating stressor event that probably triggered the onset of Janet's schizophrenic episode? What other factors may have contributed?
- 4. Identify Janet's primary delusion. How can we understand this as a way that Janet is trying to "make sense" of her collapsing world? How do her hallucinations fit together with her delusion?
- 5. Janet's hospitalization both makes her available for treatment and protects her and others. Explain the nature of danger to Janet and others that exists in her current acute condition.
