**Essay Structure Handout: Narrowing the Focus of the Topic** 

A student opts to answer the following essay topic question:

Jamieson suggests that a focus upon character would provide a better ethical basis for addressing climate change. Do you agree?

The student decides to compose an essay agreeing with Jamieson.
