

Application Exercise #2: Examples of Development in the Media

SWK 3301

Overview

Students are expected to complete application exercises, which must comply with all academic and professional standards and follow proper APA guidelines. Application exercises must be submitted online by each due date, which will occur on Saturdays at 11:59pm of assigned week.

For this assignment, you will choose a book, show, or movie with a character that is an adolescent, emerging adult, or young adult. Using course material, you will describe the physical, social emotional, and cognitive changes they are experiencing.

Directions

STEP 1: Choose a Character

Choose a character in a book, movie, or show that is an adolescent, emerging adult, or young adult.

STEP 2: Create Infographic

After reading the book or watching the movie/show write a 2-3 page paper using APA formatting guidelines to address the following:

- In 1-2 paragraphs summarize the movie/book/show
- In 2-3 sentences describe why you chose this book/movie/show and character
- In 1-2 paragraphs describe the character as portrayed in the book/movie/show
- Write 4-5 paragraphs about the character's developmental stage according to your course materials. Consider the physical, cognitive, and social-emotional development stages in this assessment. Make sure to include at least 4 direct connections to course material and remember to use citations.
- In 1 paragraph provide a personal reflection in which you discuss what you gained from this assignment.

This assignment should not be more than three pages long. APA formatting and style should be used, and proper citations should be included. Please edit your work for spelling and grammar.
