<ul> <li>(3) Literature review:</li> <li>Studies conducted previously on the same or similar topic (pro and con),</li> </ul>	Critique the literature review. How does the literature, particularly research articles support the topic?
Theory (ies) that drive(s) the study (if any)	Address these two points.
<ul> <li>4) Methods</li> <li>Participants – how many people and how selected</li> <li>Setting</li> <li>Research Question/hypothesis</li> <li>Instruments – quantitative and</li> </ul>	Critique the methods section of the article.  Describe how the points are in keeping with the type of research the article puts forth.  Address these points.

4) Findings/Results	Critique the findings/results section of the article. Are they credible? Trustworthy?
	Address the aspects discussed in the article.
