1) Abstract: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Purpose of study • Need for study, • Participants, • Instrumentation • Analyses planned, • Anticipated results, • Discussion of anticipated results 	<p>Critique the abstract.</p> <p> Discuss the items listed in the left-hand column.</p> <p>Which are present; what is the quality of each point?</p>
2) Introduction: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Includes main purpose of the study rationale or reasons for conducting the study • Questions or hypotheses to be investigated 	<p>Critique the Introduction. What is the problem the study addresses? What is the purpose of the study? What do the authors want to find out?</p> <p> Address these two bullet points.</p>
(3) Literature review: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Studies conducted previously on the same or similar topic (pro and con), • Theory (ies) that drive(s) the study (if any) 	<p>Critique the literature review. How does the literature, particularly research articles support the topic?</p> <p> Address these two points.</p>
4) Methods <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participants – how many people and how selected • Setting • Research Question/hypothesis • Instruments – quantitative and qualitative instruments • Reliability & validity • Procedures • Analyses 	<p>Critique the methods section of the article. Describe how the points are in keeping with the type of research the article puts forth.</p> <p> Address these points.</p>

4) Findings/Results	Critique the findings/results section of the article. Are they credible? Trustworthy?  Address the aspects discussed in the article.
5) Discussion <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Implications• Further research	Critique the discussion section of the article. Describe how the points are in keeping with the type of research the article puts forth.  Address these 3 points.
6) References	Describe the quality (not the number) of the references. Current? Appropriate? Related to the topic?
