Specifically, you must address the following:


- 1. List credible and relevant sources you found in the Shapiro Library during your independent research.
 - A. Include two sources that you find from your independent research.
 - B. Include the link to both sources. - 2. Evaluate your sources.
 - A. Describe how each source supports your topic and how it can help answer your research question.
 - B. Discuss why you trust the credibility of your sources and/or what questions or doubts you have about the information pr
 - C. Discuss how you think your audience will view the credibility of your sources for your argument.
- 3. **Explain the bias** found in each source.
 - A. Explain how the bias or lack of bias in each source impacts your argument.
 - B. Explain how you think your audience will respond to the bias or lack of bias in each source.

What to Submit

Submit your journal as a 1- to 2-page Microsoft Word document with double spacing, 12-point Times New Roman font, and one-inc APA style or MLA style.
