How to analyze the cultural significance of art

Ask yourself these key questions to analyze the cultural significance (or context) of art:

- 1. When was this piece made?
- 2. What historical (social, political, or religious) events were taking place at the time of its creation? How are these events reflected in this piece?
- 3. Who are the key individuals associated with this piece, either real or mythological, and what significance do these individuals have to this piece?
- 4. Where was it originally located? How does it relate to its environment?
- 5. Who was the artist that was responsible for creating this piece?
- 6. What is known about the artist who created this piece?
- 7. What techniques were used to create the piece? Is there any significance to these techniques? Are they new or innovative in some way?
- 8. What materials were used to create this piece? Do the materials have symbolic associations?
- 9. Who was the patron for this piece?
- 10. What was the relationship between the patron and the artist?
- 11. What were the patron's motives for commissioning this piece?
- 12. What types of documents did the artist or patron leave that help to explain this piece?
- 13. How was this piece used? How did it function in society?
- 14. Who was able to see this piece? Who used this piece?
- 15. What does this piece symbolize? What symbolic meaning or message does it convey to the viewer?
- 16. What is the subject matter of the piece? How does the subject matter relate to society, the artist, or the patron?
